SALES TAX

The sales tax rate in Pinellas County, Florida, is 7%, consisting of a 6% state sales tax and an additional 1% local option sales tax levied by the county.

HOMESTEAD TAX BENEFIT

Homestead tax benefits in Pinellas County, Florida, offer property tax relief to homeowners. The Homestead Exemption reduces the taxable value of a primary residence by up to \$50,000. Seniors aged 65 and older may qualify for additional exemptions. These benefits make homeownership more affordable. AVERAGE TEMPERATURE
